

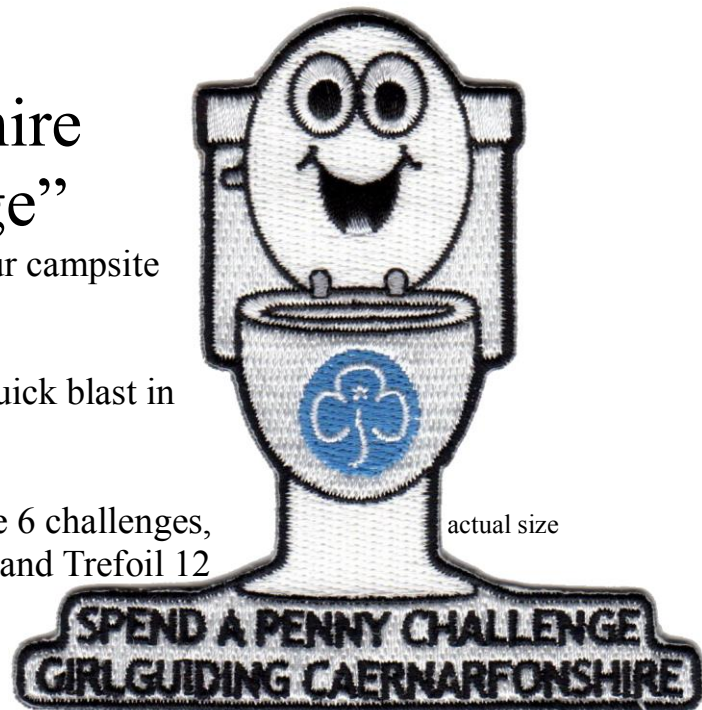

“Spend a Penny Challenge”

To raise funds to build a new toilet block for our campsite
“Felin Bach”

Tip: If using used loo roll inners give them a quick blast in the microwave to sterilise.

To gain badge Rainbows should try to complete 6 challenges, Brownies 8, Guides 10, Senior Section, Adults and Trefoil 12



1. Marble in toilet roll game - divide girls into teams with 3 toilet roll inners and a marble per team; the marble must be placed in one tube then rolled into the next - the 3 tubes being placed one over two to form a continuous run - first team across hall without dropping the marble or holding it in tubes wins.
 - Rainbows could balance a tennis ball on top of the roll and run with it.
2. Find out about 'Tippy Taps' health initiative in Africa. Try making one using instructions on the 'Tippy Taps' website www.tippytap.org
3. Decorate a toilet seat or design your own loo seat
4. Make chocolate poo using the armpit fudge recipe at end of challenge
5. History of the loo/ toilet paper – trace it's origin
6. Hygiene hand washing – learn how to wash your hands properly
7. Eco loos – find out from internet about different types
8. Water usage – how much water do you use in your house each week? Find out about hippo's that help in the water tank to use less water. Useful website : www.south-staffs-water.co.uk/publications/your_home/WaterUseHome.pdf
9. Loo roll crafts - make a pencil holder, animal etc. using a loo roll inner
10. Fill a large trefoil with pennies or do a penny hike
11. “Twinning Toilets” charity – find out about the charity and raise money in an awareness evening www.toilettwinning.org
12. Sell a brick to build a loo for “Felin Bach” or in aid of “Twinning Toilets” (Template at end of challenge)



13. Make soap or try soap carving
14. Toilet roll mummies – wrap a member of your unit, six or patrol in toilet paper so they look like a mummy. Make it a race or points for best one?
15. Watch 'Carry on at Your Convenience'
16. Learn the song “My Father's a Lavatory Cleaner”
 (Tune: “My Bonnie Lies Over the Ocean”)
 My father's a lavatory cleaner
 He works both by day and by night
 And when he comes home in the evening
 He's covered all over in Shine
 Up your buttons with Brasso
 Its only ten pence a tin

17. Visit a sewage works or water purification centre (see if you can go to a “Lake to Tap” project with your local water board)
18. Learn basic plumbing eg. change a washer in a tap or for younger girls find the stopcock in your house
19. Make up a skit with a whoopee cushion
20. Compare loo roll brands - which is best quality ie. strength and price. Compose a sketch to sell the best one
21. “Pipeline Challenge” www.wateraid.org - Form as long a line as possible and transport buckets, jars, cups or even wellies filled with water along the line without dripping a drop? Go through the playground, over the climbing frame, across a field or even around town. Or race water down two or more lines. You could even sign up and raise funds for the Wateraid “Pipeline Challenge”
22. Find facts about toilets worldwide eg. did you know that there are more people in the world who have mobile phones than toilets?
23. Learn how to dig and use a camp latrine or make a camp shower

24. Learn how to ask for the toilet in different languages abroad
25. Research different dialect words (names) for the toilet.
26. Make a loo seat photo frame
27. Find out facts about Sir John Harrington inventor of the toilet and why Thomas Crapper is more famously known for this
28. Sing - "I'm Dreaming of a Flush Toilet"
(tune: Verse 1 & 3 "Tiptoe Through the Tulips" - verse 2 "White Christmas")

29. Do fun sheets found at back of challenge.

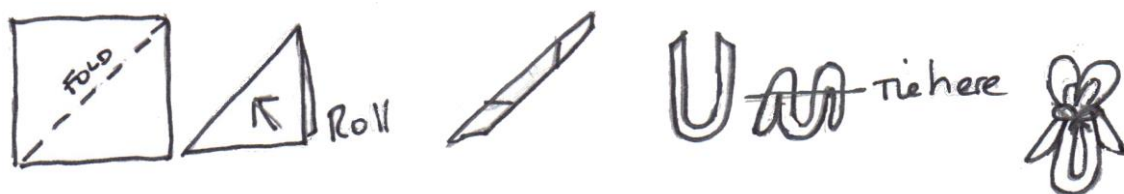
30. Make a toilet from a banana

Challenge 4:

Armpit Fudge Recipe for challenge 4

Ingredients:

(single serving) (six / patrol serving)

- 2 oz. icing sugar (1/2 cup) 1 lb. icing sugar
- 1 Tbsp butter 1/4 cup butter
- 2 tsp cream cheese 1 - 3 oz pk cream cheese
- dash of vanilla essence 1/2 tsp vanilla
- 2 tsp cocoa 1/3 cup cocoa

What to do :

- Place all ingredients in a sandwich-size plastic zipper-bag (or one-gallon zipper bag for patrol quantity)
- Squeeze out all the air
- Squish the bag (under the arm!) until all the ingredients are well mixed and there is a creamy consistency
- Add any favourite flavours or other stuff (raisins, M&M's, peanut butter, chopped nuts, etc)
